The track was released as a duet with White and Grammy-Winning artist Colbie Caillat and performed at the historic Ryman Auditorium!

She co-wrote "*Home Wasn't Built in a Day*", with **The Voice** Season 18 Winner Todd Tilghman, who performed the song on the **Grand Ole Opry**.

As a performer, Kelli has opened for Sugarland, Restless Heart, Marty Raybon, and has toured with Grammy Winning Artist John Berry. She has performed on Music City Roots, PBS, APT, The Dugger Mountain Music Hall Show, The Phil Mack International Country Music Show, and was a featured artist on Barry Waldrep's Grammy Nominated Tony Rice Tribute Album, alongside Vince Gill, John Berry, Marty Raybon, John Cowan, Emmylou Harris and more!

Kelli resides just outside Nashville, Tn, where she continues to write and perform.
